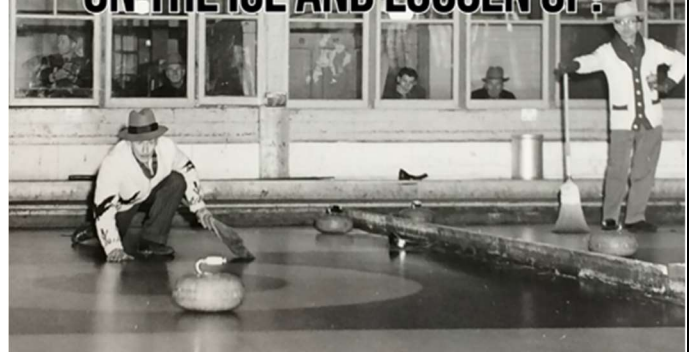

FACILITIES REPORT

You might think that summer is a quiet time at a curling rink. Not at the Callie! In addition to hosting many different groups over the summer, our Club Manager, Dean Moulding has been busy working with contractors and staff on facilities improvements.

The "heart" of the cooling system, the chiller was replaced this summer. The chiller is a large heat exchanger that uses the cold ammonia coming from a refrigeration cycle to cool the brine which flows through pipes to chill the concrete pads where the ice is made.

The Callie had the second oldest chiller among Saskatchewan curling rinks at 47 years old, so its replacement was due.

The \$150,000 chiller replacement project included other associated upgrades as well to ensure reliable operation for many winters to come, improved efficiency and reduced consumption of compressor lube oil.

Other facilities investments include the resealing of the membrane roof, a new phone system to replace the rather old, unsupported system that we had been using and repairs to the ice walls.
